



Dear Community Organization Partner:

The Streamwood Summer Celebration Committee has been hard at work planning this year's event. The festival will be held from **July 24 through July 26** at Hoosier Grove Park and promises to be a fun-filled, family-oriented weekend! This year's theme is "**No Place Like Home**" As you know, it takes a tremendous number of volunteers to bring an event of this size to Streamwood.

We need your help! Your organization can earn money as you support this community event. You will be seen by thousands of area residents, giving your organization great exposure. It's simple – sign up to run a game for a day, or the entire weekend – **the more shifts you cover, the more your organization could earn!**

We're offering a ticket sales revenue split! Here's how it works:

- To ensure all organizations are treated fairly, and the event can cover the costs (tent rental, prizes, etc.), members working from your organization collect game tickets as participants play; at the end of the weekend, all tickets will be counted
 - **The first \$1,000 worth of tickets collected will be split 50/50** between Summer Celebration and your organization
 - **Proceeds above \$1,000 will be divided 70/30** split between your organization (70%) and Summer Celebration (30%)
- Game revenue checks for your organization's share of game booth profits will be mailed 2-3 weeks after the fest
- Summer Celebration provides the game, including all associated equipment, tent, and participant prizes
 - Game operator instructions and prize levels will be posted at each booth and staff will be available to answer questions throughout the weekend

Organization requirements:

- The minimum number of adults (as specified below) must be present during assigned shifts
 - Children and young adults may assist operating the game
- Send an adult representative to the Volunteer Training on Thursday, July 23 (7:00 pm), at Hoosier Grove Park, to gather required information and communicate back to your organization/volunteers
- Manage your internal schedule of volunteers and shifts for your committed time to operate the assigned game

Games available w/required number of adults:

- Basketball Shoot (1 adult volunteer)
 - *manage/retrieve basketballs as players shoot balls into hoop; hand out prizes*
- Candy Toss Across (1 adult volunteer)
 - *similar to tic-tac-toe, players toss beanbags to get 3 symbols in a row; hand out prizes*
- Hot Shots (3-4 adult volunteers)
 - *fill water balloons for players to sling shot at each other*
- Miniature Golf (1 adult volunteer)
 - *give clubs and balls to players for a 9-hole course; hand out prizes*
- Skee-Ball (1 adult volunteer)
 - *hand participants balls for play; give out prizes*
- Ducks Game (1 adult volunteer)
 - *give prize to player based on duck pulled from stream of water*
- Fishing Game (1 adult volunteer)
 - *give fishing pole w/magnet and prize based on "catch"*
- Hot Air Balloon (2 adult volunteers)
 - *Checking in guests for their "flight" and taking payment*

Additional details:

- Organization volunteers must operate their game booth with the required number of adults throughout the committed time; you may switch out your volunteers as you need to
 - Game hours: Friday, 5-10 pm; Saturday, 12-10 pm; Sunday, 12-7:30 pm
- Your volunteers are encouraged to wear apparel representing your organization and you may display signs, banners, etc. to promote your group within your game space
- Organization volunteers operating the game will receive a Summer Celebration water bottle; cold water will be available to fill water bottles at the Information Booth
- Nothing may be sold from your game booth; organizations interested in selling promotional products should consider getting a booth in the Business Expo tent

Games sponsored by an organization will be filled on a first come, first served basis, so inquire and commit early! Don't forget – your organization may also want to be part of the Summer Celebration Parade on Saturday, July 25, at 10:30 am.
